Ephesians 5: 21 - 33



Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands as you do to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior. Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything.

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. After all, no one ever hated their own body, but they feed and care for their body, just as Christ does the church for we are members of his body. "For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh. "This is a profound mystery but I am talking about Christ and the church. However, each one of you also must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.

- 1 Timothy 5:8




Gift of Trust

For the Lord God is a sun and shield; The Lord will give grace and glory: No good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly.



Our godliness is directly related to our time management.

Luke 10:38 - 42

Now it came to pass, as they went, that he entered into a certain village: and a certain woman named Martha received him into her house.

³⁹ And she had a sister called Mary, which also sat at Jesus' feet, and heard his word.

⁴⁰ But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to him, and said, Lord, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to serve alone? bid her therefore that she help me.

⁴¹ And Jesus answered and said unto her, Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:

⁴² But one thing is needful: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.



Gift of Submission (Ephesian 5)

Submission Speaks

Here's what it says...

- I honor the leader in my husband.
- 3. I trust God to workout what's out of order in my marriage; because I'm in order.



Gift of Respect (1 Peter 3:1-5)

1 Peter 3:1-5

Wives, likewise, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, without a word, may be won by conduct of their wives, when they observe your chaste conduct accompanied by fear. Do not let your adornment by merely outward –arranding the hair, wearing gold or putting on fine apparel rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with the incorruptible beauty of gently and quiet spirit, which is very precious in the sight of God.



Gift of Encouragement

PROVERBS 14:1

The wise woman builds her house [on the foundation of godly precepts, and her household thrives], But the foolish one [who lacks spiritual insight] tears it down with her own hands [by ignoring godly principles].



3 KEY AREAS HUSBANDS NEED ENCOURAGMENT

- **Encourage your husband in the bedroom.**
- **❖** Encourage your husband is his leadership role (husband, father, career, pastor, mentor, etc.)

Gift of Loyalty (Genesis 2:24)

Cleave = Hold Fast

One Flesh = Your husband is a part of you.

- Loyalty is birthed out of a love for yourself.
- Loyalty is birthed out of a friendship with your spouse.




Gift of Confidentiality
